## ETHNOCIDE IN BELARUS

HOW LUHASHENHO'S REGIME EXTERMINATES THE BELARUSIAN LANGUAGE




«The Belarusian and Russian languages shall be the official languages of the Republic of Belarus»

(Article 17, The Constitution of the Republic of Belarus)

In 1991, 80% of Belarusians claimed Belarusian to be their mother tongue.

But, already during the first 5 years of Lukashenko's presidency Belarusian-speaking schools dropped by 10%. Their number has been steadily decreasing with only every 10th pupil taught in Belarusian in 2019.



If current trends continue, by 2030 there would be no Belarusian-speaking schools in Belarus.


«Everyone shall have the right to use his native language and to choose the language of communication. In accordance with the law, the State shall guarantee the freedom to choose the language of upbringing and instruction»



(Article 50, The Constitution of the Republic of Belarus)

**«45% of schools are Belarusian-speaking»** (Ministry of Education, 2021) In presenting statistics, the state focuses on the number of schools, not pupils and overlooks the fact that Belarusian-speaking schools are located in less populated rural areas with as few as 2-3 pupils in one class.

But the number of people who speak Belarusian is growing.



However, the state continues exterminating Belarusian language:

In 2021 more than 270 public institutions faced forcible liquidation. One of them is F. Skaryna Belarusian Language Society - the oldest public organization in Belarus.

«After Lukashenko came to power in 1994, the state policy of Belarusization was literally curtailed; active defense of the Belarusian language started being perceived as opposition»



27 years of Lukashenko's ethnocide might result in the death of Belarusian. Together with Welsh, West Flemish and Scots, it is now recognized by UNESCO as a "vulnerable" language.
